

Frequently Asked Questions

When is St Marys Indoor Shooting Centre open??

St Marys Indoor Shooting Centre is open seven days a week (except Public Holidays). We are open from 10am – 10pm Monday to Saturday and 10am – 6pm on Sunday. Please note that between 10am – 12pm Saturday the Ranges are reserved for training.

How much does it cost?

\$36 – Non SSAA member \$26 – SSAA member (must present proof of membership)
\$7.50 – Cleaning fee for members who use Club firearms.

What calibres can I shoot?

St Marys Indoor Shooting Centre is approved for Rimfire and Centrefire calibres up to 12mm. No shotgun or shot shell ammunition or tracers are allowed. Full metal jacketed projectiles are acceptable.

I don't have a firearms licence, can I still have a go?

St Marys Indoor Shooting Centre holds regular Try Shooting Days where newcomers are able to try shooting under the careful guidance of Range Safety Officers. For more information about upcoming Try Shooting Days please call the Range on 02 8889 0406

I have a firearms licence in another Australian State. Will I be able to shoot?

Absolutely. Interstate firearms licences are accepted at St Marys however it is a requirement you have your own firearms to use.

I'm an international visitor. What are the rules for me shooting at St Marys?

International visitors should contact the NSW Firearms Registry on 1300 362 562 to enquire about obtaining a permit. If you are unable to obtain a permit you will only be allowed to take part on a designated Try Shooting day.

I've moved house and need somewhere to store my firearms while my new safe is installed. Can you help?

Yes. St Marys Indoor Shooting Centre has a number of Safe Storage lockers approved by the NSW Firearms Registry that can be rented by club members. For more information stop by the Range, or give us a call on 02 8889 0406

I'm a licenced shooter can I take on an unlicensed shooter onto the range with me, to try shooting?

Not at St Marys Indoor Shooting Centre, all unlicensed shooters must go through our Try Shooting program. Silverdale Range does allow it via pre-bookings, please ring 02 4653 1440.
